

Course Request

Students and Parents:

The course request window is now open; and will stay open for 1 week, closing Friday 4/6. All current CHS students must log on to careercruising.com to request their courses for next year. Counselors have been in classrooms this past all week reviewing the process, so your students should be well-versed in how to request courses for next year what to do. In brief, students will request 6 credits of primary requests, 3 alternate credits, and then submit via Career Cruising. The login is r407- then followed by the students skyward login and password (i.e. login: r407-labatrav000, password (student ID #) 0123456). We gather all course request data and tailor our master schedule to meet student demands, after which, we auto-schedule based on students course requests. Keep in mind that we sometimes do not run an elective class if enough students have not requested that class.

Please note that families can always log on to Skyward to get an update on your student's credit status and what your student still needs to be earned to graduate on time.
