Happy Belated New Year!

Just a couple of good news announcements as we begin the new year. First of all, some great news, the Riverview School District/CHS was named to the College Board Advanced Placement Honor Roll for the 5th consecutive year! The AP Honor Roll distinction is for districts where the secondary schools "simultaneously achieved increases in access to Advanced Placement® courses for a broader number of students and also maintained or improved the rate at which their AP® students earned scores of 3 or higher on an AP Exam." Only six districts in Washington were named to the honor roll (there are 295 districts in the state). Also, RSD is one of only three districts in the nation to be named to the honor roll for 5 consecutive years! Congratulations to the AP team, our students from CHS that contribute to this award, and to all of our RSD teachers, we couldn't do it without everyone doing their part from K-12!

Next, I am pleased to announce that CHS received "The Old Main Brick Award" from the University of Arizona. This award is awarded annually by state to the high school whose current students at the University of Arizona earned the highest average GPA during their freshman year. To quote, "The award acknowledges academic excellence among our out-of-state students, and recognizes your high school as an outstanding institution." The students from CHS at the University of Arizona from the class of 2015 that contributed to this award are: Amanda Korn, Kyle Walsh, Alex Fuquay, and Tim Wunderlich. Congratulations to these fine students and their representation of CHS at the next level!

### **2017 States Assessments Important Dates**

On January 18, Cedarcrest High School will be administering a Biology winter end-of-course (EOC exam). This exam will be given to all students in the class of 2017 and 2018, who have not met the state science standard or did not pass the June 2016 EOC Biology exam. (This includes transfer students from out-of-state). Students will be given a letter notifying them of the testing time and location. An announcement in our daily bulletin will also be made the morning of the test. This test starts promptly at 7:20 AM.

On January 25, Cedarcrest High School will be administering the Algebra I winter end-of-course (EOC exam). This exam will be given to all students in the classes of 2017 and 2018 who did not pass

### **Refund Policy for Student Fees:**

Refunds for class fees must be requested by mid-term of the semester in which the class was originally scheduled. After mid-term, no refunds will be issued. 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## **Nurse's Corner...**

**Influenza** - Flu season is hitting the area hard this year. There are reports of increased hospitalizations due to the flu. Frequent hand washing, covering your cough/sneeze and getting a flu shot can help stop the flu from spreading.

From the CDC "Getting an annual flu vaccine is the first and best way to protect yourself and your family from the flu. Flu vaccination can reduce flu illnesses, doctors' visits, and missed work and school due to flu, as well as prevent flu-related hospitalizations. It's almost time to register for and purchase your Advanced Placement exams!

**You will be registering and paying online. The school office is not able to accept exam payments.** Go online to [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/480145](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/480145), or Google "Cedarcrest High School AP Exam Registration."

**Normal Registration Window: February 1 - 14, 2017**

**Late Fee Registration: On February 15, a late fee of \$20 per registrant will be assessed. The late registration window will close on February 23.**

**Price: AP exams cost \$95.00 each.**

**Financial aid for income qualified:** Cedarcrest High School desires that all students be able to take their AP exams. Financial assistance is available for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Students requiring financial assistance should email Michelle Fleming, AP Coordinator, [flemingm@riverview.wednet.edu](mailto:flemingm@riverview.wednet.edu), to learn how to apply for financial aid.

**To register and purchase exams:** We know that your parents may desire to register you for exams; however, we strongly recommend that you are present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered. To complete registration, you must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until you reach the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. Cedarcrest High

School's AP program continues to grow, and we are excited to offer families the convenience of online registration and payment. This is the process used by all of our neighboring high schools. Please be sure to have a credit card or debit card available before beginning registration. The school office is unable to accept exam payments.
